NATIONAL NIGHT OUT

Tuesday August 4 is the annual neighborhood-based crime and drug prevention event known as National Night Out.

VDOT PAVES THE WAY

Resurfacing our neighborhood roads is underway. You may have first noticed the painted lines, arrows, and boxes marking particularly rough patches that will need some subsurface work. Next you would have seen the NO PARKING signs. Then the

milling machines and dump trucks began removing the existing pavement and repairing subsurface problems. The last step is applying the new surface.

The work has started on Karl Road and will proceed east to Ft Hunt Road. VDOT has promised us a schedule, and it will be posted on the website as soon as we get it.

We all have a part in this, too. We need to identify rough patches or serious problems that VDOT missed, before they simply pave them over. We also should **pay attention to the NO PARKING signs.** VDOT, in conjunction with County police, will ticket and tow cars in the work area.

We'll talk more about this at the June meeting.

RIGHT OF WAY RESTORATION AT FAIRFAX ROAD BRIDGE

If you have traveled by the new pedestrian bridge on Fairfax Road, you may have noticed that it no longer looks like a clear-cut logging

site. The County planted some tree, but nowhere near the number taken out. But that's water under the bridge, so to speak!

A few of our HHV neighbors have taken a direct interest in improving the area. Libby Shough, who lives on Fairfax Road, and several other neighbors have put some serious effort into improving the look with substantial upgrade around the bridge and along the path. Their efforts are appreciated and we send out a heartfelt thank you.

Others are interested in the restoration, too. One neighbors suggested a tree-planting party to restore the

canopy. Another suggested that we establish a memorial garden with dedicated trees, shrubs, and plants. These are all great ideas.

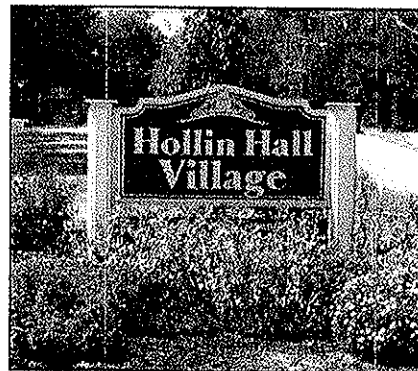
