AIRCRAFT NOISE

This summer's outdoor time has been a real EAR opener. The sounds of the season now include low flying, loud aircraft to accompany the sounds of lawnmowers and air conditioning units. The new flight patterns cross the friendly skies of HHV on a continual basis.

A group of concerned citizens has organized to work to change the flights to a more neighborhood friendly pattern. HHVCA has joined with the Villamay Aircraft Noise Abatement Campaign to work for these changes. The Campaign initiated both a petition drive and outreach to elected officials. It is also closely monitoring the efforts of the National Airport Community Working Group (CWG) to ensure local community interests are considered.
